RIDE & GRAB

PURPOSE:

To enjoy rides while connecting with other chapters across the state.

RULES:

- **Membership Requirement:** Participants must be in good standing with their parent family (Legion, Auxiliary, Sons) and their ALR chapter.
- **Sign-In Process:** Each participating chapter will maintain a sign-in book for riders to record their name, chapter number, and date when they take or reclaim a tag.
- **Tag Limit:** A chapter can only take a tag from another chapter once before that chapter reclaims it. This ensures local chapters can reclaim their tags without being completely taken.
- **Display Responsibility:** Each chapter is responsible for purchasing & displaying their own tags and any tags they have taken. Additionally, they must keep a sign-in book to document who took or reclaimed tags, and when. Department is not responsible for any expenses incurred.
- **Fair Play:** To ensure fairness, claiming tags during a district meeting is prohibited if it falls within your parent family district. This is in part due to riders not breaking down into districts.
- **Year-Round Participation:** The ride & grab challenge is open year-round, starting January 1st, 2025. All participants are required to wear ALR attire. However, from April 1st to October 31st, all ride & grab activities must be conducted on a motorcycle. **Note: This is exclusively for ALR members.**
